CLOTHING:	 Waterproof Rain-coat with hood or hat and Rain-pants 2 pair of shoes (including Waterproof Boots or old pair of shoes that can get wet) Pajamas Daily change of socks and underwear Heavy and light shirts Warm jacket and sweater 2-3 pairs of long pants (add shorts in warm weather) Gloves (nice for canoeing) and hat Plastic bag for dirty clothes
TOILETRIES:	Toothbrush and toothpaste Soap and shampoo Brush or comb Washcloth and towel Flip-flops for showering Bath Mat or extra towel (cabins do not have bath mats)
EQUIPMENT:	Backpack (or book bag) Water bottle and hot beverage travel mug Alarm Clock / watch Flashlight with extra batteries
RECOMMENDED:	Lip salve, sunscreen Phone Book / story to read to kids at night Guitar-if you can play calm mellow music at night for your kids! Garbage bags Personal Reading Material Games you can play with your cabin group A few "special" stuffed animals to help with homesick kids.

Alcohol or Drugs Matches or fireworks Food (including soda, chewing gum, and candy) (except sack lunch for the first day) Valuables Electronics (video games / movie players) Pets Weapons (knives, guns, etc.)
