Educators will typically work independently from 3:00–6:00 pm Monday–Thursday running after school programing at a local Tacoma Elementary School. Educators teach classes ranging from squid dissection, geology, ornithology, reptiles, sustainable systems, teambuilding, orienteering, and many more. Training provided.

Qualifications: Staff model the YMCA core values of respect, caring, honesty and responsibility. We seek individuals dedicated to providing today's youth with positive, outdoor experiences. Required qualifications include a displayed ability to maintain a positive work attitude, experience working with children, and a First Aid/CPR/AED certification. Favorable qualifications include education and environmental science majors.
